Idea / summary of planned project

Aims, objectives, general approach	<p>The project deals with senior citizens, promoting their active role in a local community they are part of and developing a close connection of senior citizens with young generation. The project contributes to active citizenships with emphasis on European context and amplifies different social and ICT skills of both old and young generation.</p> <p>All partner countries will discover the history of their local community on the basis of senior citizens' memories, pictures, experiences, stories and movies from the past. All investigation or its parts will be completed by younger generation. A web tool with information from all partner countries will be developed. The project will also deal with important topics that are up-to-date nowadays: influence of city agglomeration on local communities of incorporated towns and villages and development of local communities related to the history of XX century.</p> <p><u>The project will implement:</u></p> <p><u>For learners</u> (senior citizens as member of local community)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - promote their active citizenship and social inclusion - learn to reflect on the recent history of the XX century - improve ICT and social skills and better understanding of present world - promote the inter-generational dialogue - enlarge their experience through international partner meetings
